



Jubullum Grant Allocation Summary

1. Support for Parents, Jarjums and Community

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : To combine the following 3 applications into 1 project.

1. Water Safety for our Jarjums
2. Mothers and Jarjums -Play 2 Learn Early Childhood Meeting Place - Start Up
3. Womens mental health and wellbeing through cultural activities and connection

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$50,000** to complete the project as written.

Conditions requested: For the development of a MOU with Jubullum LALC to ensure both organisations have a chance to participate in the programs.

2. Clean Up Jubullum

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : Highly favoured project.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$23,500** to complete the projects as written.

Conditions requested: To Investigate if Scrap steel, cans, bottles or car batteries can be collected and sold to build sustainability and extend the program.

3. Football Field for Jubullum- Making space for the new Turtle Divers

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : With Confusion around ASBESTOS contamination of the old site and the new site location the group has expressed the need for it in the town.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$112,500** towards the development of the football field at any location the organisation chooses.

4. Jubullum Playground - repairs, shade cover, seating and garden space

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : The lack of disability access or play equipment is the only issue.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$63,000** to complete the project as written.

Conditions requested: For the development of a MOU with Jubullum LALC to ensure both organisations have a chance to participate in the program and for future development of the site to investigate the inclusion of paths, extra seating and disability accessible play equipment.

5. Wahlabul Men's Group, Jubullum Community Support

Wahlabul Men's Group

Discussions : The level of risk associated with a large asset purchase for a new organisation was too high to award the grant in full. Lack of facility to store the equipment or strategic plan on how the equipment would be utilised in the community. Support for the formation of the organisation was extremely high. The codesigners would like to offer the organisation support in engaging a culturally appropriate advisor to develop a strategic plan for the organisation to assist in gaining funding once fully established. Additionally the funding for the BBQ Trailer (conditional that the trailer is transferred to an organisation that services the Jubullum Village (Gungyah or JLALC)), a catering budget and a budget to access for trips away to link up with other men's groups or similar organisations.

Overall Consensus : Awarded a total of **\$50,000** for the following

1. \$20,000 - BBQ Trailer and Supplies
2. \$20,000 - Travel and Catering Budget
3. \$10,000 - Culturally appropriate advisor to assist develop the organisation

6. Drake Hall Upgrades

Drake School of Arts and Progress Association

Discussions : To combine the following 2 applications into 1 project.

1. Drake Hall Kitchen Upgrade
2. Drake Hall Air Conditioning, Lighting and Electrics

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$85,000** to the upgrades to Power, Kitchen and Air Conditioning. Any additional grant funding that remains can be spent toward additional future proofing of the Drake Hall or assistance in making the Drake Hall an appropriate venue during disasters.

Conditions requested: For Drake School of Arts and Progress Association to supply NRCF with additional purchase list if monies are left after requested upgrades have been completed.

7. Jubullum LALC Depot clean up and fit out and machinery repairs

Jubullum LALC

Discussions : Concerns arose over the lack of shared usage of equipment. The Training component is highly favoured and feel it is important for more members of the community to have tractor licences.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$10,000** to complete and extend the training competent of the grant.

Conditions requested: For any additional funds be spent on training in the community.

8. ONGOING CLEANUP AND MAINTENANCE

Jubullum LALC

Discussions : The Project was favoured.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$55,000** to complete the projects as written.

9. COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS- BUILDING INCLUSIVE COMMUNICATIONS

Jubullum LALC

Discussions : The website quoted was way too expensive. \$5000 is a reasonable budget for a website. A4 sign boards for around town are too small and expensive to achieve the required outcome.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$15,000** to complete the website and graphics, Staff to produce communications, distributing the information and repairs made to the large public noticeboard.

Conditions requested: For any additional funds be spent to assist the project. Investigate the potential of a MOU with Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation to ensure both organisations can communicate effectively.

10. Connecting and protecting our Assets for community

Jubullum LALC

Discussions : Support to assist with making the premise secure and upgrades to power.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$70,000** to complete the projects as written.

Conditions requested: For any additional funds be spent on upgrades to the premise.

11. Jubullum - Stadium and Tuckerbox Upgrades

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : Support for part of the project. The plan and layout of the stadium needs to be revisited due to the potential of the storage being inaccessible for elder members of community that are integral in the operation of the stadium.

Overall Consensus : Awarded **\$93,000** towards upgrades to either premise.

Conditions requested: For any additional funds be spent on upgrades to the premise. A MOU with Jubullum LALC with a shared user agreement between organisations. Investigate the potential of 2 keys and a booking system to ensure both organisations can utilise the premises.

REJECTED APPLICATIONS

1. Person Centred Emergency Planning - getting ready for the next big thing

Kyogle Together Incorporated

Discussions : The Project lacked the support from local organisations, the group felt it wasn't the best bang for our buck.

2. Food Security - starting from each home and building momentum

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : The Project had a high risk of not being sustained long term.

3. Fixing the internal road systems in Jubullum.

Gungyah Ngallingnee Aboriginal Corporation

Discussions : The Project has been completed with additional funding.
